FOR THE SELECTION OF TWO HUNDRED (200) YOUTHS FOR THEIR TRAINING AND
INSTALLATION WITHIN THE CLUSTER OF DIGITAL SAFETY OF GOODS AND PERSONS.-

I. BACKGROUND AND RATIONAL

Within the framework of the implementation of its missions in terms youth economic empowerment and in order to contribute to the operationalization of the Integrated Import-Substitution Plan in the digital economy sector, the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Civic Education intends to mobilize some young entrepreneurs, in view of their installation in the area of exploitation, installation and management of GPS systems. Thus the launching of the present call for applications aiming to select two hundred (200) youths, for their installation in clusters of the digital safety of goods and persons.

II. OBJECT OF THE CALL FOR APPLICATION

The present call for application has as object the selection of two hundred (200) youths, for their training and installation within the cluster of digital safety of goods and persons.

III. CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED BY CANDIDATES

Can apply, young entrepreneurs fulfilling the following conditions:

- be of Cameroonian nationality;
- be aged of at least 18 years and of at most 35 years at the deadline for the submission of applications;
- be registered at the National Youth Observatory (NYO);
- be a holder of the Biometric Youth Card;
- be a holder of at least a GCE O/L in four subjects excluding religion or Probatoire;
- have a good mastery of ICTs;
- be available during the training periods in one the following towns: Garoua, Yaoundé, Bafoussam and Douala.

IV. CONSTITUTION OF THE APPLICATION FILE

The application file shall comprise the following elements:

- a stamped handwritten application to the Minister of Youth Affairs and Civic Education;
- a photocopy of the birth certificate;
- a photocopy of the last certificate obtained or a transcript;
- a photocopy of the National Identity Card or the receipt where applicable;
- a photocopy of the Youth Biometric Card or a receipt where applicable.

V. VALIDITY OF PROJECT FILES

Application files shall be deposited latest **Monday May 04 2026**:

- in **hard copy**, in a sealed envelope, at **3:30 PM** at MINJEC's Central Mail Service or at the deconcentrated and devolved services;
